I am requesting funding for the Borough of State College for Calder Way Transportation Improvement in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Borough of State College, located at 243 S Allen Street State College, PA 16801. The funding would be used to advance critical upgrades to both above- and below-ground systems, including the full replacement of water, sewer, and stormwater utilities and enable the construction of a curb-less, multi-modal streetscape that prioritizes accessibility, safety, and economic growth in the heart of downtown.
