I am requesting funding for the Madera Volunteer Fire Company for Fire Station Improvements in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Madera Volunteer Fire Company DBA Moshannon Valley Fire Department, located at 2720 Main Street Madera, PA 16661. The funding would be used to replace their 30-year-old engine tanker that is at the end of its useful life and a generator so that the fire station can continue to provide services during power outages and emergency situations. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will replace an aging engine tanker, a huge need for a rural community that is without fire hydrants. A generator is a valuable use of taxpayer funds as it will provide reliable energy to allow the fire department to properly respond to emergency calls and continue operations during power outages and emergencies.

The project has a federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in Section 306 of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act, 7 U.S. Code section 1926(a).
